



Financial Aid Registration *2009/2010 Season*

The DC Youth Orchestra Program offers tuition discounts based on income level and family size. Registrants (parents) will be able to apply for 50% and 25% tuition discounts, depending upon **household** income. Apply for these discounts based on the total family size and the income of the wage earners in the household. The following is the schedule of discounts:

If you qualify please do the following:

- Complete a registration form for the session for which your child/children will be attending.
- Complete a financial aid application form.
- Provide copies of one or more of the following documents:
 - State income tax return for the household, verifying income for the most recent year available.
 - Federal income tax return for the household, verifying income for the most recent year available.
 - Social Security Administration annual statement of income from most recent year for each wage earner in the household.
 - Statement verifying current unemployment from the unemployment office, signed by representative from the unemployment office for each wage earner in the household.
 - Documentation of approval for TANF
- Pay a deposit amount while waiting for the processing of your application. (Please see a staff member for help determining the deposit amount.)

Submitting financial aid paperwork in the Fall will substantiate eligibility for the subsequent Winter and Summer Sessions (of the same year). Financial Aid paperwork must be resubmitted prior to the Fall Session each season.

Submit all documents to the DCYOP office. Your child will be registered for classes, upon the receipt of your completed registration form, financial aid form, supporting paperwork, and deposit amount. Please allow two (2) business days for processing of your application.
