#### **What is the JazzDC Youth Ensemble?**

Brand new for the 2024-2025 season, the DC Jazz Festival, DC Youth Orchestra and Sitar Arts Center presents the JazzDC Youth Ensemble. The ensemble is designed to give students interested in jazz a space to develop their skills in the following areas: improvisation, sight reading, ensemble playing, and general musicianship. In addition, the students will be able to network and build a community of like-minded people around this unique art form.

#### **Who is eligible?**

Intermediate to Advanced students ages 12-18 on any instrument. Ideal instrumentation might include Alto Saxophone, Tenor Saxophone, Baritone Saxophone, Trombone, Trumpet, Flute, Violin or other string instrument, Guitar, Piano, Bass, Drums, Percussion, and Vocals.

#### **When does the program take place?**

The program will take place on Wednesday evenings from 7:00-8:30 pm starting in October 2024.

#### **How much does it cost to participate?**

## Auditions Requirements

Each student should prepare two jazz standard compositions (sample list provided below). Accompaniment will be provided at the audition.

1. If student is comfortable, they should prepare to improvise over the chorus; if not, student can prepare only the melody for each standard.
2. For blues standards, prepare to play over two choruses, for other standards, prepare to perform one chorus.
3. Be prepared to perform the list of scales below
4. Student may also elect to perform a composition of their choice, such as an etude, study, or work in the jazz style.
