



Registration Policies for the 2026-2027 Season

Registration Deadlines:

- Early Bird Registration: April 25 – July 25 (5% discount)
- Late Registration: September 5 (\$50 late fee applied)
- Audition Early Bird Registration: August 15 – September 12 (5% discount)
- Sept 12, 2026, Parent Student Orientation – TES
- Sept 19, 2026, First Day of Fall Classes and Rehearsals
- January 23, 2026, First Day of Spring Classes and Rehearsals
- Summer 2027 Early Bird Registration: December 12, 2026

Class/Rehearsal Cancellation Policy

- DCYOP reserves the right to cancel or adjust class schedules for any reason. Students or parents displaying unsafe or inappropriate conduct may be expelled without a refund. Refer to DCYOP's Code of Conduct and Bullying Policies.

Withdrawal, Refunds, and Payment Arrangements

Processing Fee: \$50

1. All withdrawal and refund requests must be submitted in writing to tuition@dcyop.org. Requests not sent to this email address will not be processed.

Refunds

2. Requests received before the first day of classes and rehearsals will be refunded in the amount paid, less the \$50 processing fee.
3. No refunds will be issued on or after the first day of classes and rehearsals. Approved refunds will be processed within one week of receiving the written request.

Payment Arrangements

4. Requests made before the first day of classes and rehearsals: DCYOP will cancel all arranged payments. Any funds paid will be refunded, excluding the \$50 non-refundable deposit.
5. Requests made on or after the first day of classes and rehearsals: DCYOP will cancel all remaining arranged payments. No refunds will be issued.



Arrangement Options:

Fall/Spring/ Summer (*installment options available for summer only)

1. (6) Six-Month Installment (\$15 processing fee)
2. (4) Four-Month Installment (\$12.5 processing fee) *
3. (2) Two-Month Installment (\$10 Processing fee) *

Failed Automatic Payments:

- DCYOP will issue an electronic invoice, granting one week for payment.
- After 30 days, a \$30 late payment charge will apply, and a second invoice will be sent, granting one week for payment.
- If the second invoice is not paid after one week and no communication has been made DCYOP will cancel the registration, and the student will not be permitted to attend classes/rehearsals until a payment or other arrangements have been made and authorized by the Director of Operations.
